



### **Conor Kehoe**

Conor is a Senior Adviser and former Senior Partner at McKinsey & Company. He chairs the International Integrated Reporting Council (IIRC) – a coalition of 70 organisations dedicated to improving ‘ESG’ reporting. He is a member of Blackrock’s Private Equity Advisory Board in New York and he founded and co- leads McKinsey’s Board Intelligence Forum - bringing the latest management thinking to the boards of large companies.

Previously, he founded McKinsey’s Private Equity Industry Practice and was a founding member of McKinsey New Ventures. Originally a software engineer, he also led McKinsey’s Tech and Telecom Practice in Europe. He was a member of McKinsey’s Global Risk Committee and its Partner Evaluation Committee (New Ventures).

Conor was a founding member of a UN Development Goals organisation bringing IT to schools in developing countries – backed by Canada, Finland, Switzerland and Ireland.
