In 2019 she was appointed as a Trustee of The Economist Newspaper Ltd. She continues as a non-executive director at The Takeover Panel as well as at Collar Capital.

Previous roles include chairmanship of Land Securities Group plc as well as non-executive directorships of Barclays plc and Man Group plc. Dame Alison has also served on the boards of Friends Provident plc, Welsh Water, Gallaher Group, Vitec Group plc and MFGlobal Inc.
