



Noel Harwerth

E. Noel Harwerth is Chairman of the UK Export Finance agency and serves of the board of the UK Department of International Trade. She serves on the boards of One Savings Bank (SID), and Scotia Bank Europe (SID). She serves as an advisor to the Bank of England on RTGS/CHAPS and is a member of the Regulatory Decisions Committee of the FCA. She served on the boards of Standard Life (Chair, Risk committee, member Audit and Nomination committees) from 2012 to 2018, and London Metal Exchange (Audit and Risk, Nominations Committee, and Enforcement Committee) from 2012 to 2018.

She was Chairman of GE Capital Bank Europe until April 2017 and served as Chairman of Sumitomo Mitsui Bank (Europe Middle East and Africa) from 2004 to June 2015. In 2006 she was appointed by the UK Government to the Board of the Tote (Chair Audit Committee) and served on the board until its privatization. She has served on the boards of Alent (Chair Compensation committee), Corus (British Steel), Logica (Chair Compensation committee), Impellam Group (SID), RSA Insurance Group (Chair Risk committee), Avocet Mining, Anglo Irish Bank, and Dominion Diamond Corporation (Chair Audit Committee).

Mrs. Harwerth was appointed by the UK government as Partnership Director of London Underground and served in that role from 2003-2008, having previously served on the Board of Transport for London, where she chaired the Audit Committee.

From 1998 to 2004 Mrs. Harwerth was Chief Operating Officer of Citibank International PLC in London. She was responsible for infrastructure and governance of Europe's first truly pan European bank, with branches in 18 countries. Prior to joining Citicorp in 1988, Mrs. Harwerth held senior positions in Dun & Bradstreet and Kennecott Copper Corporation, where she worked on large, complex international mining transactions.

Mrs. Harwerth was educated at the University of Texas in Austin and holds a Jurisdoctor degree from the University of Texas Law School. She holds both U.S. and British citizenship. Mrs. Harwerth is a liveryman of the Worshipful Company of International Bankers, Chairman of the UK chapter of Women Corporate Directors, member of The Committee of 200 and International Women's Forum, and served on the board of the British Horseracing Authority from 2013 to 2019.
