David currently chairs Domestic & General Ltd, PZ Cussons Plc and JoJo Maman Bebe Ltd. He also chairs the Government-backed Parker Review on ethnic diversity in business.

David formerly chaired Imagr Ltd (2021-23), J.Sainsbury plc (2009-19), The White Company Ltd (2020-22), Hammerson plc (2013-20), Logica plc (2007-12), 3i Quoted Private Equity plc (2007-09) and the Hampstead Theatre (2012-20). His executive career from 1974 to 2006 was at Unilever, NatWest Investment Bank, Christie's and GUS. Following the GUS de-merger, he began a nonexecutive career in 2007 which – like his executive career - has been unusually broad in terms of sector, including consumer, retail, business services and financial services. He sat on the Boards of Experian, Burberry and Reckitt Benckiser as well as chairing the companies noted above.

He was one of the four founding chairs of Chapter Zero, and has served on the Investment Association's Executive Remuneration Working Group. He is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants and a member of the Association of Corporate Treasurers. He was a Founder Advisor in the creation of the Board Advisory Partnership's Chairing in Practice programme.
